

Sketch Draft

The sketch draft is divided into two parts which roughly follow the same pattern from Experiment 1.

Part 1: Human talking about cat

Stanza 1: The persona is reminded of his/her cat who has been gone for fifteen days.

Stanza 2: The persona then recalls a time when the cat refuses to take the food it is given and instead goes out to find its own food.

Stanza 3: The persona recalls another time when the cat does not want attention and goes about its own day, not caring for its human at all.

Stanza 4: The cat returns and now wants food and companion.

Stanza 5: The persona thinks a cat can be both dependent and independent, a concept so foreign to him/her.

Part 2: Revelation

Stanza 4: The cat mentions that humans only think in binary, one or the other, either or.

Stanza 5: The cat recalls that its human refuse to accept help and would rather burden him/herself.

Stanza 6: This is an example of being exclusively independent without noting that being dependent doesn't mean the human is weak.

Stanza 7: The human accept and embrace this new ideology.
